Bosco Eduardo Fernandes has more than 20 years of experience in Telecommunications, Information Technology and Media Industries.

He chaired the UMTS Forum ICT Working Group that published a number of Reports on Services, Content and Applications, Devices and Security Awareness for 3G Networks. He now heads the EC IPv6 Task Force for Industry wide spread deployment in Europe and Chairs the UMTSF and GSMA Joint Mobile TV Group. He has also contributed to a number of studies in the Forum including the recent HSDPA and LTE Reports.

Mr. Fernandes received a degree of Dipl. Ing. in Electronic engineering in Munich, Germany and holds an Executive MBA. He is a senior member of the IEEE communications society and a member of the International Telecommunications Academy of Russia (ITA). He is also a member of the Executive Board in the ITU.
