

## Chairman of Committee 5

### ORGANIZATION OF THE WORK OF COMMITTEE 5

To cover the Conference agenda items assigned to Committee 5, the following Working Groups have been established:

#### Working Group 5A (WG 5A)

*Terms of reference:*

- 1 to consider allocations and regulatory issues related to the Earth exploration-satellite (passive) service, space research (passive) service and the meteorological satellite service in accordance with Resolutions **746 (WRC-03)** and **742 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.2*)<sup>1</sup>;
- 2 to consider the results of ITU-R studies regarding sharing between the mobile-satellite service and the SRS (passive) in the band 1 668-1 668.4 MHz, and between the mobile-satellite service and the mobile service in the band 1 668.4-1 675 MHz in accordance with Resolution **744 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.7*);
- 3 to consider the results of ITU-R studies on compatibility between the fixed-satellite service and other services around 1.4 GHz, in accordance with Resolution **745 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.17*);
- 4 to consider the results of studies, and proposals for regulatory measures if appropriate regarding the protection of the EESS (passive) from unwanted emissions of active services in accordance with Resolution **738 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.20*);
- 5 to consider the results of studies regarding the compatibility between the radio astronomy service and the active space services in accordance with Resolution **740 (WRC-03)**, in order to review and update, if appropriate, the tables of threshold levels used for consultation that appear in the Annex to Resolution **739 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.21*);
- 6 to consider such consequential changes and amendments to the Radio Regulations as may be necessitated by the decisions of the Conference (*item 3*)\*;

2 to consider possible changes in response to Resolution 86 (Rev. Marrakesh, 2002) of the Plenipotentiary Conference: “Advance publication, coordination, notification and recording procedures for frequency assignments pertaining to satellite networks” in accordance with Resolution **86 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.12*);

3 to consider such consequential changes and amendments to the Radio Regulations as may be necessitated by the decisions of the Conference (*item 3\**);

4 to review, and take appropriate action on, the Report from the Radiocommunication Assembly submitted in accordance with Nos. 135 and 136 of the Convention (*item 5\**);

#### *Terms of reference:*

1 requests from administrations to delete their country footnotes or to have their country name deleted from footnotes, if no longer required, in accordance with Resolution **26 (Rev.WRC-97)** (*item 1.1*);

2 to consider the results of ITU-R studies on technical sharing and regulatory provisions for the application of high altitude platform stations operating in the bands 27.5-28.35 GHz and 31-31.3 GHz in response to Resolution **145 (WRC-03)**, and for high altitude platform stations operating in the bands 47.2-47.5 GHz and 47.9-48.2 GHz in response to Resolution **122 (Rev.WRC-03)** (*item 1.8*);

3 to review pfd limits in the band 17.7-19.7 GHz for satellite systems using highly inclined orbits, in accordance with Resolution **141 (WRC-03)** (*item 1.18*);

4 to consider the results of the ITU-R studies regarding spectrum requirement for global broadband satellite systems in order to identify possible global harmonized fixed-satellite service frequency bands for the use of Internet applications, and consider the appropriate regulatory/technical provisions, taking also into account No. **5.516B** (*item 1.19*);

5 to consider such consequential changes and amendments to the Radio Regulations as may be necessitated by the decisions of the Conference (*item 3\**);

6 to review, and take appropriate action on, the Report from the Radiocommunication Assembly submitted in accordance with Nos. 135 and 136 of the Convention (*item 5\**);

7 in accordance with Article 7 of the Convention, to consider and approve the Report of the Director of the Radiocommunication Bureau (*item 7.1\**):

- on the activities of the Radiocommunication Sector since WRC-03 (including issues relating to Resolution **74 (Rev.WRC-03)** and definitions of HEO and HDFSS);
- on any difficulties or inconsistencies encountered in the application of the Radio Regulations.
